Jesus said, 'anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it' and yet he sent out his disciples, to act not as children but as adults to exercise his ministry in the world. There is a paradox and a tension between these two teachings of Jesus.

Jesus did not say, unless you are childish... Yet in many ways the church seems to require of its members, a childishness, rather than the openness of the child and discourages personal discernment.

On this day we will explore what it means to have an adult faith and yet the openness of a child. This will involve looking at personal discernment, its context in the community of faith and at those attitudes, both internal and external, that hinder growth into mature faith.

This day will involve some input and reflections on faith and growth into maturity, space for personal reflection and prayer, some sharing in small groups and will conclude with reflective worship.

Revd Nick Helm is the Bishop's Advisor in Spirituality and Chaplain to Whirlow Grange. His journey of faith has included steps that invited a more grown up spirituality. These were both challenging and life-giving and have stimulated the reflections that will be shared on this day.
